1. Purpose of Sale

This puppy is sold as a companion pet only, with no breeding rights. The Buyer agrees that the puppy will be spayed or neutered no later than 24 months of age, as outlined in the attached Spay & Neuter Agreement, which is incorporated into this contract.

2. Health Guarantee

The Breeder provides a 1-Year Health Guarantee covering serious, life-threatening congenital and hereditary conditions only, as detailed in the attached Health Guarantee Contract, also incorporated herein.

3. Veterinary Care & Buyer Responsibility

The Buyer agrees to:

- Take the puppy to a licensed veterinarian within 7 business days of taking possession
- Maintain regular wellness exams, vaccines, flea/tick/heartworm prevention
- Provide proper nutrition and appropriate exercise
- Not expose the puppy to high-impact activities during growth (no forced running or jumping)
- House the puppy indoors as a family companion, with love and attention
- Never breed the puppy
- Failure to comply may void any and all guarantees outlined in this and related contracts.

4. Breeder Support for Life

The Breeder agrees to offer lifetime support for the dog. This includes:

- Advice on health, behavior, training, grooming, nutrition, and general care
- Referrals to trusted professionals if needed
- Support during transitions (moving, family changes, illness, etc.)

- Open communication via email, phone, or text throughout the dog's life
- The Buyer agrees to keep the Breeder updated with major life events (spay/neuter, health diagnoses, training progress, etc.), and to notify the Breeder if any issues arise.

5. Rehoming & Return Policy

This puppy may **NEVER** be surrendered to a shelter, rescue, pet store, or third party. If the Buyer is ever unable or unwilling to care for the puppy for any reason, the puppy must be returned to the Breeder—no matter the dog's age, health, or circumstances. The Buyer may not rehome, sell, gift, or transfer ownership of the puppy to another person or entity without express written consent from the Breeder. No refund is guaranteed for returned puppies. The Breeder may assist in rehoming if requested, but all placements must be approved by the Breeder. This policy exists to ensure the lifelong safety and stability of every puppy we produce. If a returned puppy is found to have been neglected, abused, improperly socialized, or otherwise wrongfully cared for, the Breeder reserves the right to blacklist the Buyer from all future litters. **This is a zero-tolerance policy intended to protect the health and well-being of our puppies for life.**

6. No Breeding Clause

This puppy is sold without breeding rights. Any litters produced—intentional or accidental—will be considered a violation of this contract. The Buyer agrees to pay a **\$5,000 penalty per litter** and may be required to return the dog to the Breeder.

7. Limitation of Liability

The Breeder's total liability is limited to the original purchase price of the puppy. The Breeder is not responsible for veterinary expenses, training costs, damages, emotional distress, or legal fees incurred after the sale.

8. Grooming Requirements

The Buyer acknowledges that the Standard Poodle is a high-maintenance, non-shedding breed that requires regular grooming for its health, comfort, and well-being. Failure to meet these grooming requirements can lead to serious health concerns including skin infections, matting, ear problems, and restricted movement.

The Buyer agrees to the following grooming expectations:

- **Brushing:** The coat must be thoroughly brushed at least 3–4 times per week to prevent matting.

- **Professional Grooming:** The dog must be professionally groomed every 4–8 weeks, depending on coat length and style.
- **Bathing:** The dog should be bathed regularly using appropriate canine shampoo and conditioners.
- **Ears:** Poodles are prone to ear infections. Ears must be kept clean, dry, and checked weekly.
- **Nails:** Nails must be trimmed regularly to prevent pain or foot deformities.
- **Teeth:** Routine dental hygiene, including brushing or vet-approved chews, is strongly encouraged.

The Buyer agrees to keep the dog well-groomed throughout its life and understands that failure to do so may result in neglect, which may void health guarantees and lead to disqualification from future purchases.

9. Transfer of Ownership & Acknowledgement

The Buyer understands and agrees to all terms and conditions outlined in this Sales Contract, Spay/Neuter Contract, and Health Guarantee.

This contract is binding and enforceable in the state of Arizona.
